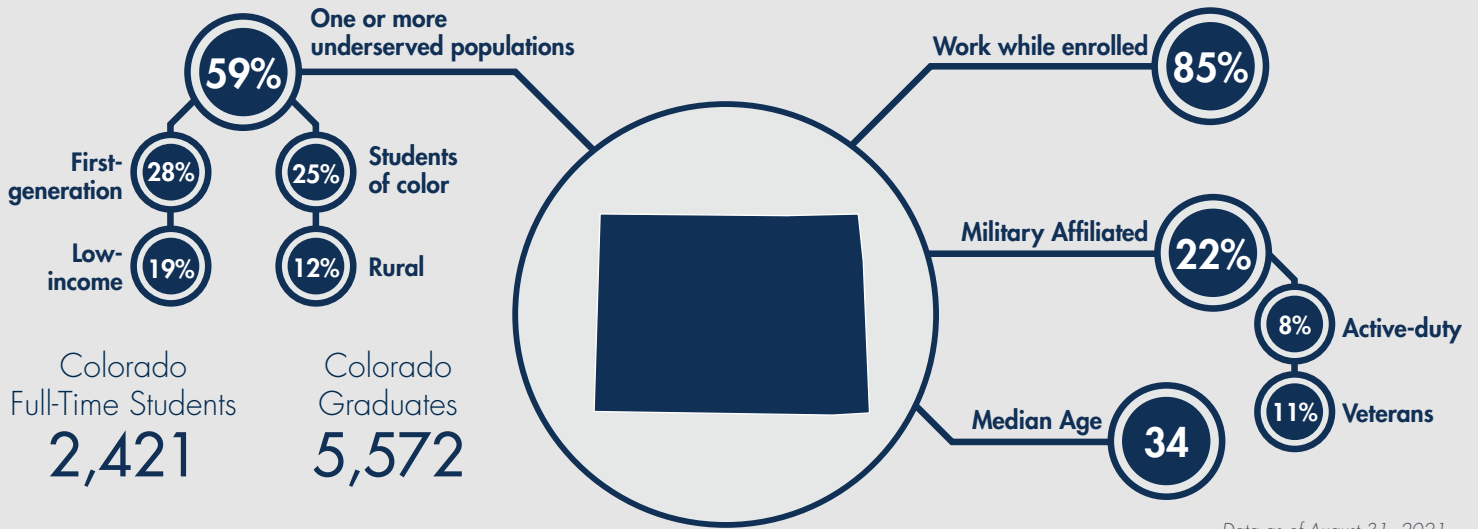

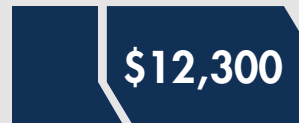

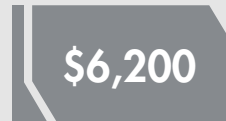
Average increase in salary compared with pre-enrollment salary.
