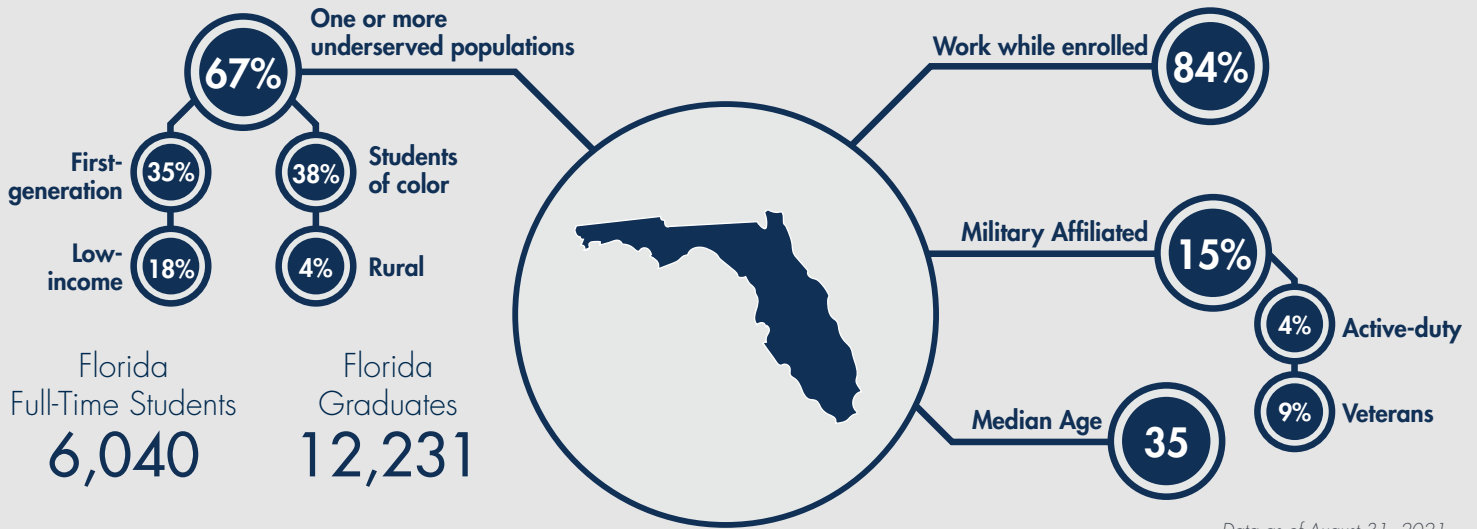

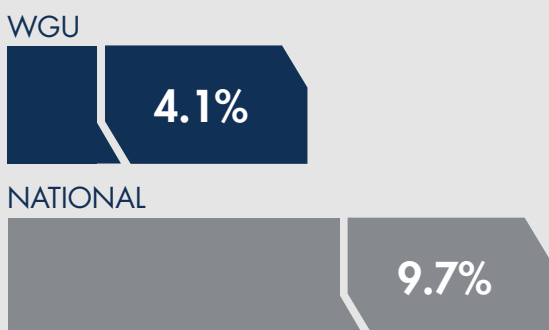

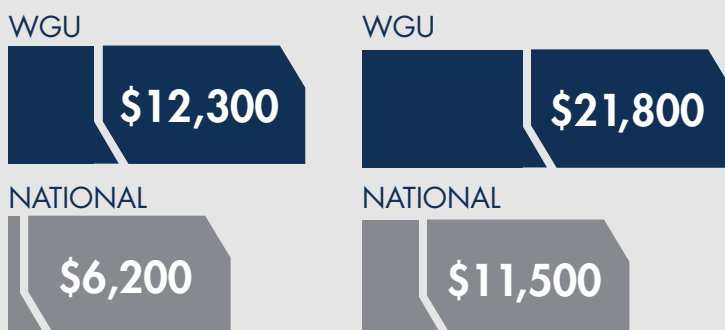
A Better Return on Student Investment
